Grayling at Ilkley and The Grayling Society

Quite possibly there has been a large population of grayling at Ilkley for at least the last 10,000 years. Local grayling legend Francis Walbran had prolific sport at Ilkley in the late-1800's and we still have big populations here now.

Grayling provide excellent sport at Ilkley from late-August right through to the end of the winter season on 14th March. During the autumn large shoals can be reen rising in many places on the Ilkley AA stretch and fly fishing is the best tactic - either dry fly or nymph. Then from December onwards trotting bait comes into its own with a weighted fly, fished along the river bed, also catching some fish.

At Ilkley AA, for just £36, we offer a half-season ticket that runs from mid-September to mid-March or you can buy day permits, either via this website or from local outlets.
